IV. Discussion -

a) **Local Historical Registry Plaque –**

- Chair Angel presents examples of plaques that the High School Welding Class created and that these plaques are preliminary ideas. Further states that school is out for the summer and changes or new ideas can be discussed with the school staff once the school is back in session. *Discussion of the plaque will continue at the August meeting.*

b) **Historic Context study, South Union Street –**

- Member Stuart states that she has not been working on the project recently and would like to continue the discussion at the August meeting.
- Planning Director states Lindsey from History Colorado was contacted about the South Union Project. She stated that any information gathered could be used to develop a historic context, contribute to a survey of any remaining resources in the area, or support outreach materials such as a walking/bike tour or online map. Additionally, oral histories could be collected and shared with the Archives and Museum.
- Member Angel stated that his vision for the study could support the development of a walking and biking trail.

c) **Florence Context Survey Project monthly report –**

- Member Wintz states the report outlines the Florence Archives activities along with upcoming events that the committee will be participating in. Expanded on the 250/150 Commission that the Archives is working on as well.

d) **San Juan Bautista Cemetery –**

- The Planning Director states that work on the preliminary property evaluation form continues and will be submitted to History Colorado for review.
